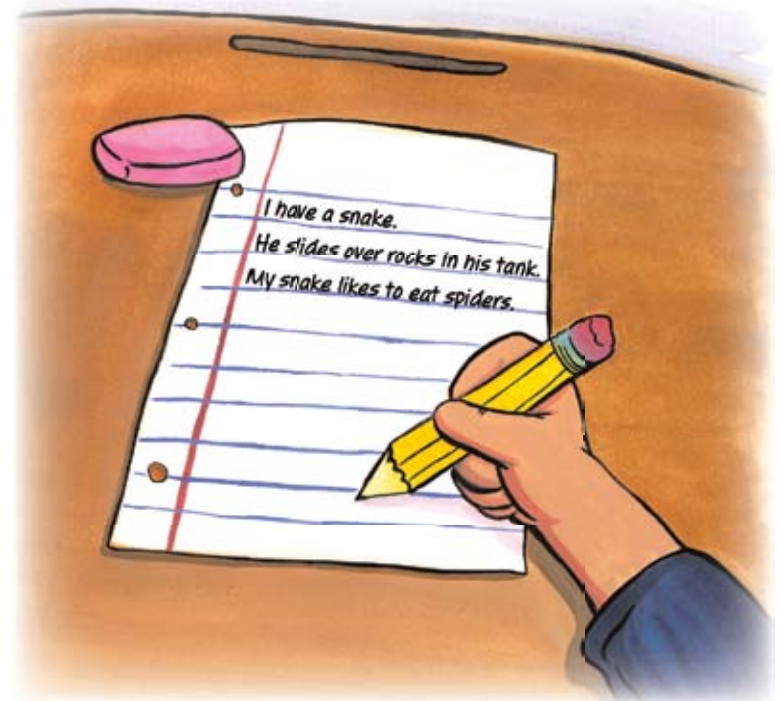


Tell Me a Story

Learn to Read



This is a game for two or more players.
Use words from the list on the next page to write a story together.
Each player chooses five words from the list on the next page.
The first player writes a sentence using one of his five words.
The next player adds another sentence using one of his five words. Keep taking turns and adding sentences until all the words have been used. Try to make the sentences flow together as a story.
Take turns reading your story out loud.



NOTE TO PARENTS

This activity gives your child an opportunity not only to practice the lesson words in the book, but also to be imaginative and think creatively. If your child knows other words that begin with these consonant blends, encourage him to use these words in the story as well.
